**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER 8
OF THE FORSYTH COUNTY CODE ENTITLED
"CABLE TELEVISION SYSTEMS"
(FORSYTH COUNTY ATTORNEY'S OFFICE)**

WHEREAS, effective January 1, 2007, N.C.G.S. 153A-137, which conferred authority on counties to award cable franchises, was repealed by Session laws 2006-151; and effective January 1, 2007, N.C.G.S. 66-351 was enacted giving the State exclusive authority in this State for cable service provided over a cable system and stating that counties may not award or renew a franchise for cable service; and

WHEREAS, these legislative changes eliminated the County's authority to enforce the provisions of Chapter 8 of the Forsyth County Code, entitled, "Cable Television Systems";

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners as follows:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 8 of the Forsyth County Code, entitled "Cable Television Systems," consisting of Sections 8-1 through 8-71, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
