
1. The FY19 Adopted Budget for Behavioral Health Services included \$350,000 for foster care placements, specifically for therapeutic foster care placements that are contracted in the Department of Social Services. Additionally, as the fiscal year starts, DSS enters into several contracts with foster care agencies and encumbers a significant amount of funding for foster care service. This transfer was necessary to ensure that DSS has enough funding to provide foster care placements during FY19.
