RESOLUTION GIVING NOTICE OF INTENTION TO REDUCE THE
SALARY, ALLOWANCES, AND OTHER COMPENSATION OF A
NON-INCUMBENT SHERIFF OF FORSYTH COUNTY WHO TAKES
OFFICE IN DECEMBER 2014

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of Forsyth County, pursuant to the provisions of N.C.G.S. 153A-92, hereby gives notice of intention to reduce the salary, allowances, and other compensation of a non-incumbent Sheriff of Forsyth County who takes office on the first Monday in December of 2014 to begin at 80% of the market reference point for Job Class 781 (Sheriff) in accordance with the Compensation Plan and Personnel Resolution for Forsyth County, which is an annual salary of \$99,174.40. An incumbent who is elected Sheriff of Forsyth County shall receive a salary adjustment July 1st in accordance with the average performance adjustment for eligible regular employees pursuant to the provisions of Section 4 of the 2013-2014 Budget Ordinance.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the salary, allowances, and other compensation for a non-incumbent Sheriff as designated herein shall take effect at the time the person elected to the office in the general election takes office.

BE IT STILL FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this resolution shall be delivered by the Clerk to the Board of Commissioners to the Director of the Forsyth County Board of Elections.
